## Cleaning and Disinfection Guidelines

This document is brought to you by Virox™ ProBeauty. Review your state regulations below and learn how Rejuvenate™ disinfectants will help you achieve compliance.

### Definitions and General Requirements\*

- ◆ Disinfectants are chemical agents registered with the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for use in a hospital setting as a bactericide, fungicide or virucide.
- ◆ Establishments must have supplies for disinfecting instruments used to perform manicures or pedicures.
- ◆ Treatment tables must be disinfected after each use with a disinfectant.

### For Non-circulating Foot Spas After Each Use\*

1. Drain water from basin and remove visible debris.
2. Clean surfaces with soap or detergent, rinse with clean water and drain.
3. Apply disinfectant according to manufacturer's instructions and ensure surface remains wet for the required contact time.
4. After disinfecting, rinse with clean water.

### For Circulating Foot Spas After Each Use\*

1. After cleaning foot spa and removable parts, fill basin with clean water and add the appropriate amount of liquid disinfectant.
2. Circulate disinfectant for the product's contact time.
3. After disinfecting, drain and rinse with clean water.

### Instruments, Implements, and Other Tools\*

- ◆ Single Use items must not be used on more than one client and must be disposed of after each use.
- ◆ All reusable instruments, implements and other non-porous tools must be cleaned and disinfected in the following manner before use:
  1. All foreign material must be removed from the tool, washed with soap and hot water, rinsed in hot water and dried.
  2. Tool should be placed in a covered wet disinfector (soaking tray) for complete immersion of tool. Tray must contain a disinfectant other than an alcohol which is used following manufacturer's instructions for tool immersion.
  3. All disinfected tools must be stored in a clean, dry, closed container.
